School-Wide Expectations & Procedures

Cafeteria Expectations:

- 1. Line up quietly and remain in the assigned order.**
- 2. Follow directions of supervisors.**
- 3. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself**
(No throwing or playing with food)
- 4. Use inside voices.** (Shouting, yelling and being boisterous is not allowed)
- 5. Remain in your seats until you are called upon.**

Assembly Expectations:

- 1. Walk in quietly in assigned order and sit down where directed.**
- 2. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.**
- 3. Watch for the signal to get quiet immediately.**
- 4. Be attentive during the assembly.**
- 5. Clapping to show appreciation is great. Booing, whistling, hooting or other rude behavior will not be tolerated.**

Restroom Expectations:

- 1. Students going to the restroom must have a pass.**
(One student per class at a time).
- 2. No loud talking, visiting, playing, or vandalizing in the restroom.**
- 3. No markers, pens, pencils, or jackets are allowed in the restrooms.**
- 4. Notify a teacher immediately if someone is breaking the rules.**
- 5. Clean up before leaving. Paper towels are to be thrown into the trash can.**

Hallway Expectations:

- 1. Move quietly in the hallways and keep walking on the RIGHT.**
- 2. No running, yelling, or pushing in the hallway.**
- 3. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.**
- 4. Follow teacher directions.**
