**EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY ELIGIBILITY DATES
HIGH SCHOOL, MIDDLE SCHOOL AND ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS
2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR
SIX-WEEK GRADE REPORTING SCHEDULE**

The chart below lists the dates that principals must use to determine eligibility for high school, middle school and elementary school students for the 2016-2017 school year. Please ensure that each school staff member who is coaching, directing, or sponsoring **any extracurricular activities** on your campus is familiar with these dates. Please remember that **all** extracurricular activities are included, and the calendar is **not** limited to only athletic and University Interscholastic League (UIL) activities.

DATE	ACTION
Sept. 30	End of first six weeks of school. All students' grades are checked.
October 7	Students gain or lose eligibility based on Sept. 30 grades.
October 21	Grade check for all students currently ineligible.
October 28	Students gain eligibility if all classes are passed as of October 21.
November 11	End of second grading period. All students' grades are checked.
November 18	Students gain or lose eligibility based on November 11 grades.
November 18 (4:00) – November 27	All students academically eligible due to one-week or longer student holiday.
December 9	Grade check for all students currently ineligible.
December 16	Students gain eligibility if all classes are passed as of December 9
December 16 (4:00) – January 1	All students academically eligible due to one-week or longer student holiday.
January 13	End of third grading period. All students' grades are checked.
January 20	Students gain or lose eligibility based on January 13 grades.
February 3	Grade check for all students currently ineligible.
February 10	Students gain eligibility if all classes are passed as of February 3.
February 24	End of fourth grading period. All students' grades are checked.
March 3	Students gain or lose eligibility based on February 24 grades.
March 10 (4:00) - March 19	All students academically eligible due to one-week or longer student holiday.
March 24	Grade check for all students currently ineligible.
March 31	Students gain eligibility if all classes are passed as of March 24.
April 13	End of fifth grading period. All students' grades are checked.
April 20	Students gain or lose eligibility based on April 13 grades.
May 5	Grade check for all students currently ineligible.
May 12	Students gain eligibility if all classes are passed as of May 5.

NOTE:

- To be eligible for the first six weeks of the school year, a student must have been promoted the previous school year. (**Middle School**)
- To be eligible for the first six weeks of the school year, a student must either have received at least five credits toward graduation the previous school year **OR** must have received an average of at least five credits toward graduation for each previous year of enrollment in high school. (**High School**)
